

Adverbs

- Explain that adverbs are words that describe actions (verbs). Adverbs say how something is happening.
- Model some adverbs, for example “I walked to the store quickly,” or “the dog barked scarily.” The walking was quick, the barking was scary.
- Point out that adverbs usually end in “-ly.” (See the mini lesson on affixes.)
- Ask students to find adverbs in the text. Have them think, pair, share about which action is described by the adverb.
- Discuss how adverbs are helpful for understanding the text.
