

## Captions

- Explain that a caption is words that go with a picture to give the reader more information.
- Have students find a caption, then ask: “How does this caption connect to the picture? How is it helpful?”
- Ask students if they have seen a caption before in another book. Have them think, pair, share about the helpful information it gave.
- Model an example yourself: “There was a photograph of a person in a book I read, and the caption told me their name. That meant I could connect the picture of the person to the text where they were mentioned, and I knew what they looked like.”
