

Prepositions

- Explain that prepositions are words that say where something is.
- Model prepositions by asking a student to sit on a chair, then ask them to crawl under a table. Point out that “on” and “under” are prepositions.
(Optional: Give each student a movement with a preposition in it to demonstrate.)
- As a group, write a list of other words that are prepositions.
- Have students find the prepositions on a page of their book. Point out that prepositions are important for explaining exactly where something is.
