1 Read a chapter of the book and list all the nouns you can find in the box below. (There will be lots and lots!)

2 There are different types of nouns:  
Nouns – names of things  
Proper nouns – names of people and places  
Pronouns – me, you, we, they

3 Proper nouns are names that have capitals ... like people's name, the names of countries, or the names of groups.  
Circle any proper nouns you can find in your list.

4 Pronouns are words that can replace other nouns. Instead of saying "Alex and Riley went to school" you can say "They went to school".

Pronouns are words like : I, you, they, he, she, we  
Why do you think pronouns are helpful?
