- Contractions are when two words are joined together.

 Can not = can't

 (The apostrophe is replacing the missing 'n' and 'o'.)
- Read a chapter of your book and make a list in the box below of the contractions you can find in the text.

- Look at your list, and for each word, write out which words the contractions are joining together.

An apostrophe (A-PO-STRO-FEE) looks like a comma, but it sits up above. It makes contractions, but it has other jobs too! Y'all'd've is one of the longest contractions! Try to say it out loud. What do you think it means?
